In 1958 the last of Milwaukee’s orange and cream streetcars trundled their way across the famous Wells Street viaduct and 1963 since the last North Shore Line train left for Chicago. TMER&THS endeavors to bring the memories of these and other electric transit operations back to life through print, pictures and programs.
